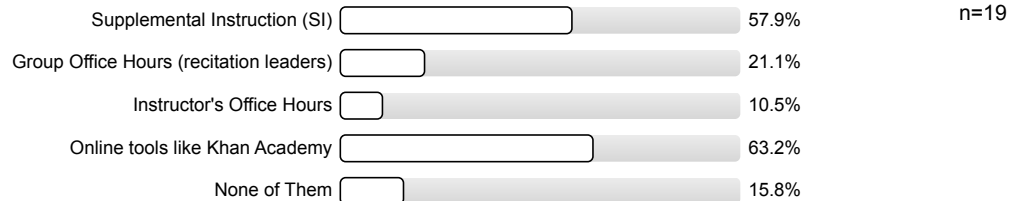

Histogram for scaled questions

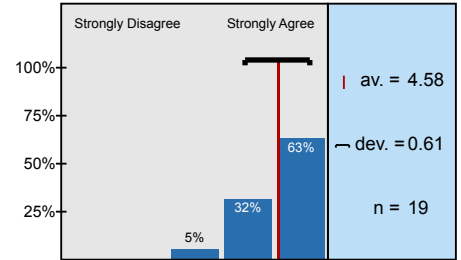
