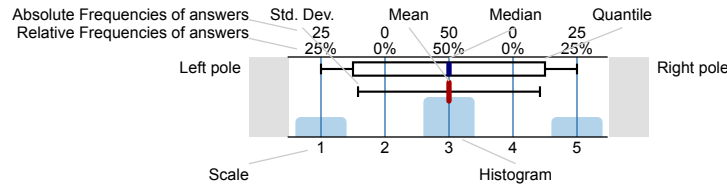

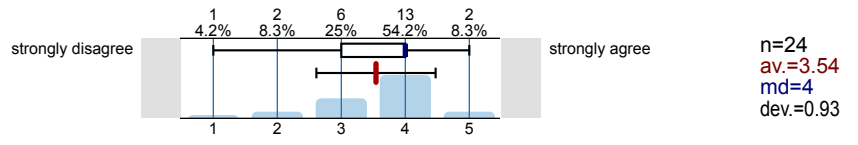

1.4) What helped your learning the most in this course?

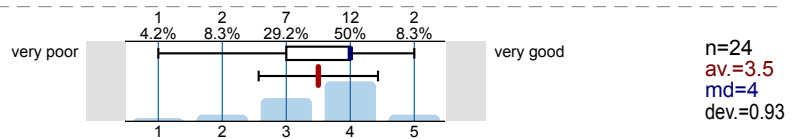
- Butler videos

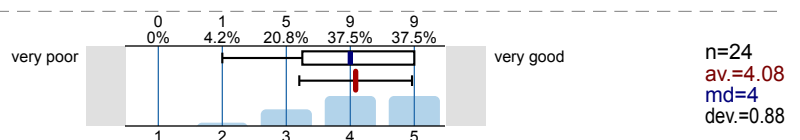
1.5) What changes could have been made to enhance your learning in this course?

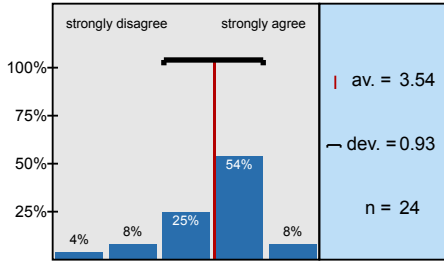

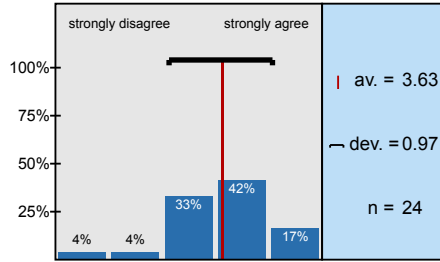


Histogram for scaled questions

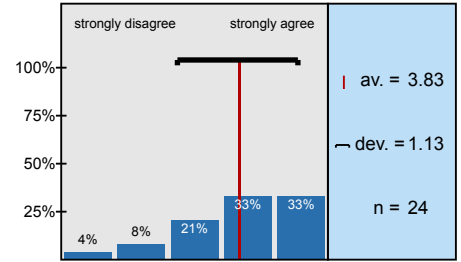

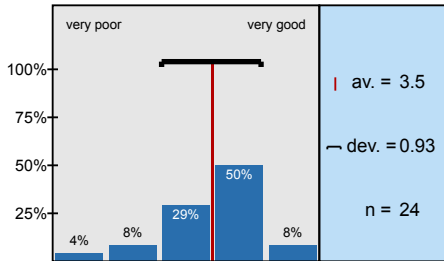

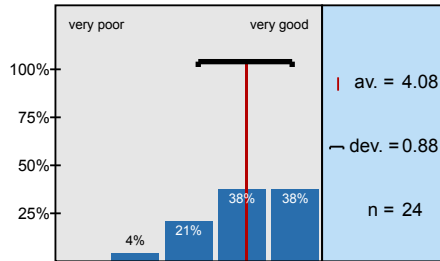
